Build Your Foundation:

Some one once said it's better to build your house on rocks instead of on sand. There are several successful people that have never been formally trained at what they do. Some say college is not for everyone.

I personally feel that one can gain training and experience in a variety of ways. Let's take the field of acting. First of all, I believe that acting is a talent, like singing or painting, and therefore it cannot be learned- but it can be perfected through time and experience. So, acting class gives you a space to gain experience.

Second, never pay an extraordinary amount of money for acting classes- Please! There are excellent classes for \$200-\$300 a month. I believe that acting class is helpful in tuning your instrument. But only you know if a class is right for you. Find a class where you feel you are

one of the least talented actors- making it extremely challenging to work with your fellow classmates.

Whenever you become the best in your class you are no longer growing as an actor. But you have to feel safe in the class environment, so that you're willing to take chances, feel vulnerable, and make mistakes. Make sure that you and the teacher communicate well.

You don't have to like the teacher, just respect them and feel as though they want to see the best in you. Try to go to class at least once a week. Make sure that you are required to perform in your class every week. But pay close attention to the other performances, because sometimes your greatest discoveries come from other people's triumphs and mistakes.

I would recommend, when you are looking for an acting class, that you audit several. Your spirit will tell you where you belong. An acting school I recommend you

audit in the Los Angeles area is Playhouse West in Burbank. I had life changing experiences there. I found that Meisner is an amazing technique to study.
